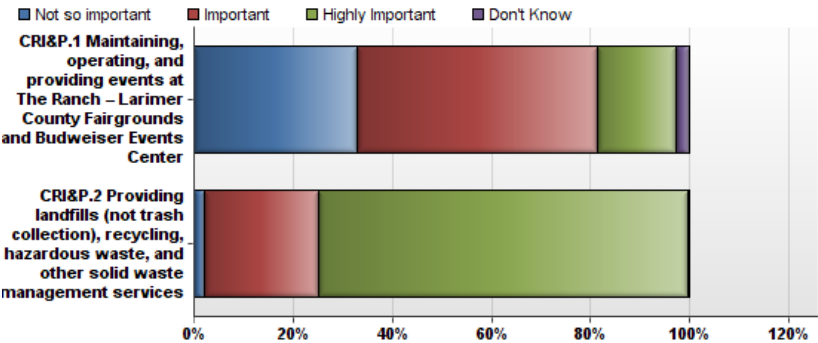


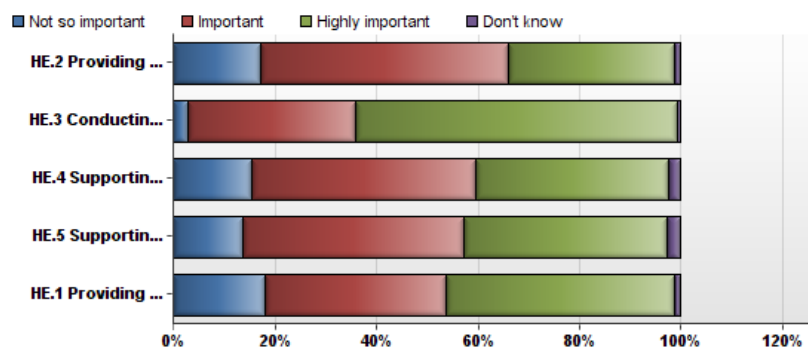

1. Community Resources, Infrastructure and Planning Services How important is each service to you?



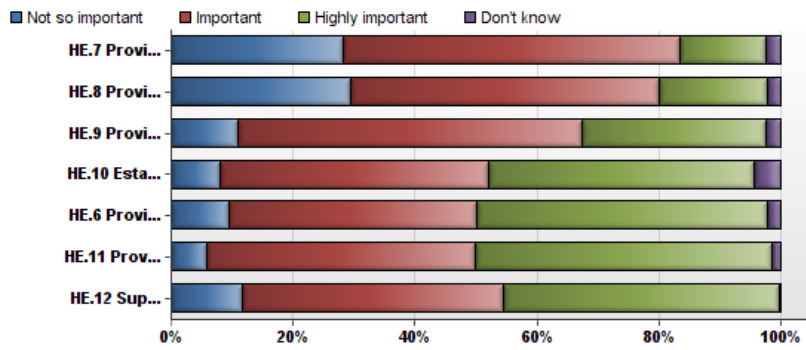

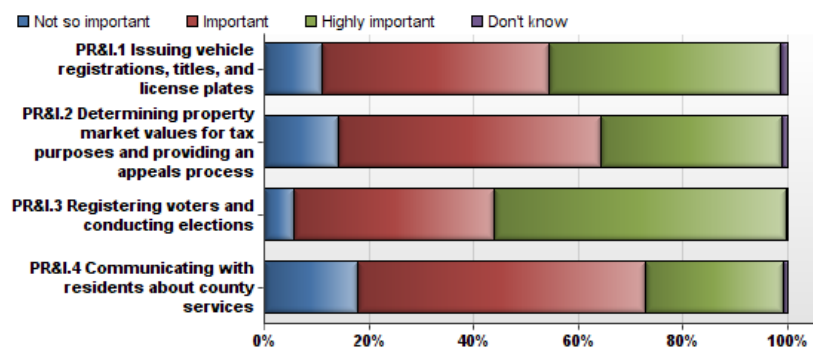

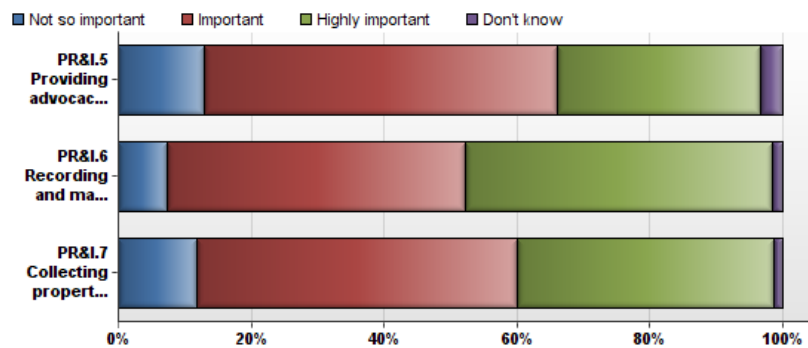

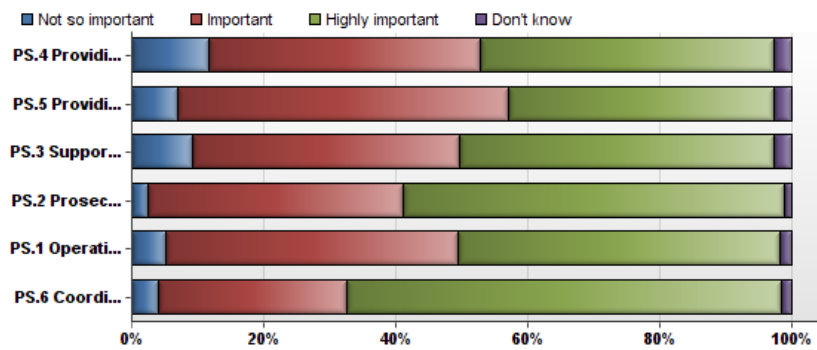

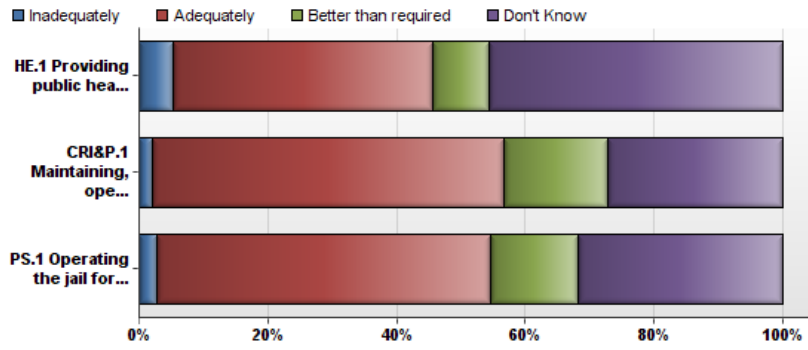

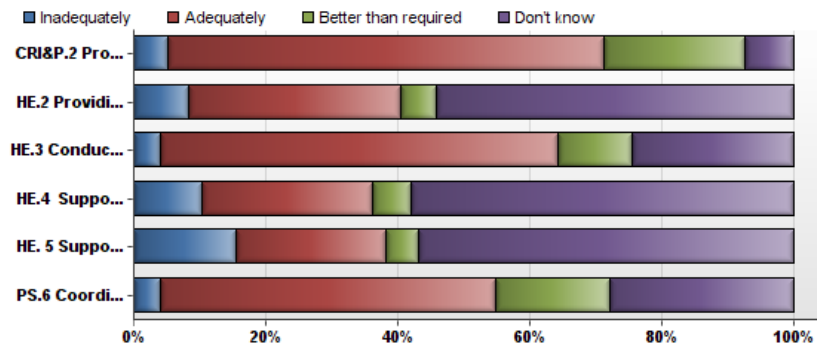

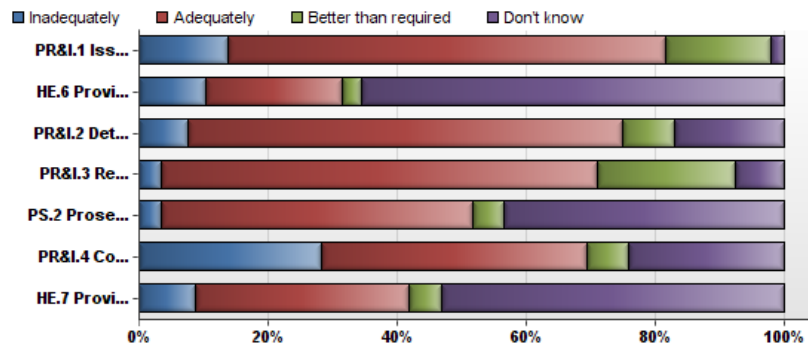

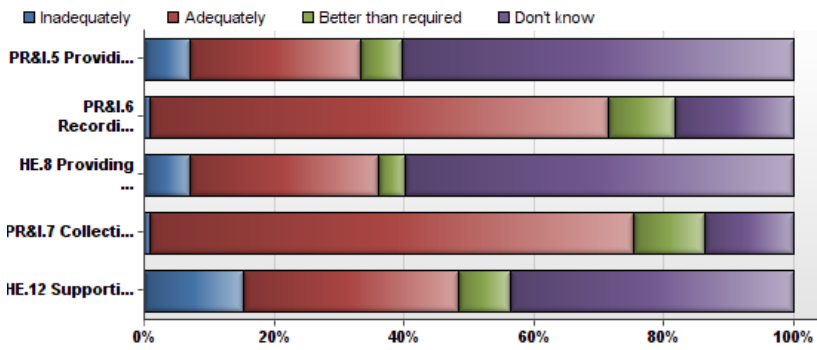

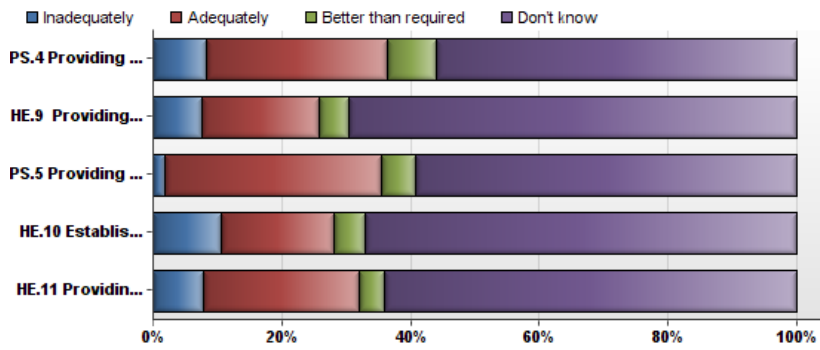

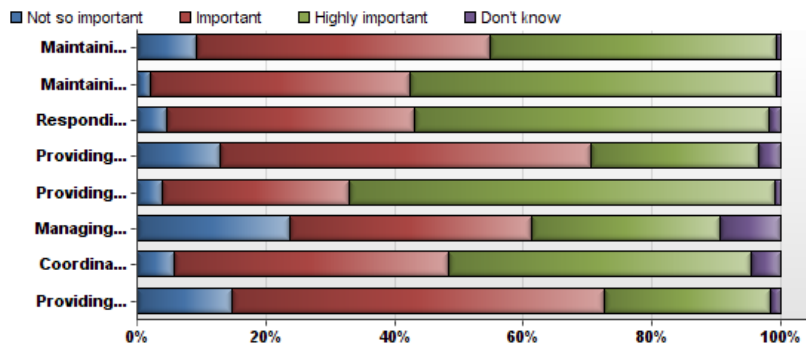

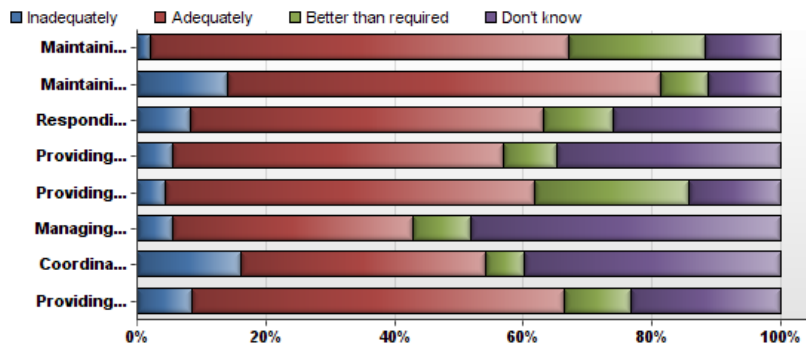

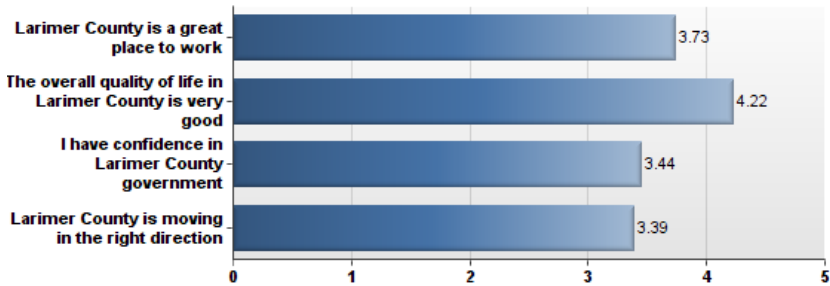

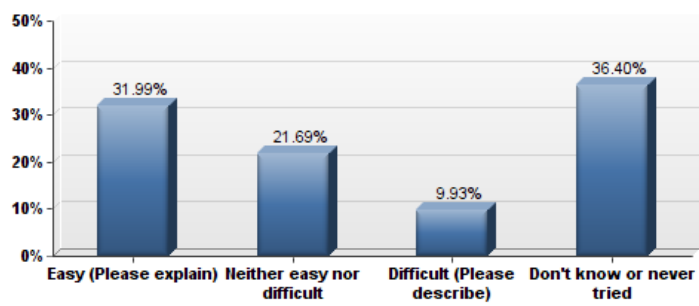

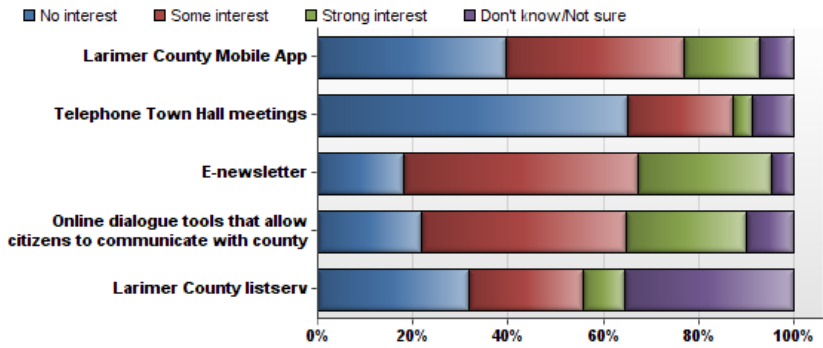
