

ELECTION LEGAL NOTICE

June 28, 2022

To the Electors of Larimer County:

Pursuant to Colorado Revised Statutes, Section 1-5-205, notice is hereby given that a Primary Election will be held on Tuesday, June 28, 2022, between the hours of 7 AM and 7 PM.

The election will be conducted as a mail ballot election for political parties that are participating in the Primary Election. A mail ballot, return envelope, and voting instructions will be mailed during the week of June 6, 2022 to every active unaffiliated voter and every active voter affiliated with a participating political party, in Larimer County. Eligible electors who are not affiliated with a political party may cast a ballot of one major political party in the Primary Election. Voted ballots may be returned by mail with adequate postage (one first-class stamp) or may be hand delivered to a designated 24-hour ballot drop box or a Voter Service and Polling Center.

24-HOUR BALLOT DROP BOX LOCATIONS (open June 6 – June 28)
