## Collaborative Outreach Plan Update

In process:

- Meeting with Governmental Partners (8/18) to refine logistics Includes such tasks as coordinating logistics, coming to agreement on approach to community, coordination of language, etc.
- Coordination of mechanisms of current outreach happening in the community
- Modifications to Root Cause Analysis buckets

#### 2 Main Questions:

- 1. What are the recommended ways in which to spend money allocated through ARPA?
- 2. ARPA is a tool, not the driving factor of recovery, so what also needs to be addressed through the recovery to long-term resilience process?

**End Goal of Outreach Planning Process**: In a collaborative way, create a space in which inclusive feedback can address both questions in which to form recommendations for leadership

#### **Timeline For Outreach**

#### Challenges:

- Flooding Impacts
- Interim Final Rule Guidance
- Delta Variant affects capacity of partners & comfortability of public

Initial Timeline: Through end of September

Other partners are looking at end of September – early October.

Proposal for Reporting on Feedback: Mid-Late October



#### **Recovery Collaborative Facilitation**

- Focus is to shift away from recovery as a separate operational function and instead integrate recovery projects/programs/needs into daily operations/strategy – Outreach process will inform this further (i.e. what teams will form)
- OEM will continue to facilitate the community outreach process, however as we move further away from initial recovery into longer-term recovery and resilience, central facilitation of the LRC will transition from OEM to a team leads approach (ex. Broadband)






## **GENERAL ARPA UPDATE**

- Treasury opened the portal this week for the Interim Report and Recovery Plan report, both due August 31.
- Not yet a large amount of spending or information to report as we are just beginning the process to gain public feedback.
- Most counties and cities are in the same place and will not have much information in these first reports.
- Criminal Justice Services may need significant infusion due to revenue shortfalls.

- Bucket C Misc. County Costs




## Bucket A – Health Impacts (External)



- \$500K in immediate needs
- Possible BH grants
- Consideration for '22 grants, construction costs



## Bucket B – Economic Impacts (External)



- \$500K for immediate needs
- Project priorities and ideas will come out of the public participation process




## Bucket C – Infrastructure (External)



- \$500K for immediate needs
- Currently only allocated project is the Red Feather Lakes water/wastewater feasibility study



## Bucket D – County Costs (Internal)



- \$500K for immediate needs
- Projects approved currently: CJS
  Ventilation, CJS
  Vicarious Trauma,
  Coroner's Office
  Respirators and
  Administrative
  costs
