

Community Transition Services

Transition Services help individuals living in nursing homes explore options for community living.

? What services are available to me?

- **Transition Coordination:** Help before, during, and after your transition from a long-term care facility to an apartment, home with family, or assisted living. This process includes finding affordable and accessible housing.
- **Life Skills Training:** Training to help you meet your physical, emotional, social, and economic needs while remaining independent in the community. Including, managing a budget, and navigating public transportation.
- **Home and Community Based Services (HCBS):** Offers in-home assistance with personal care, managing medication, rides to appointments, cleaning your home, preparing meals, and doing laundry.
- **Home Delivered Meals**
- **Peer Mentorship:** Support from a peer who has been through Transition Services to support you during your transition.
- **Transition Setup:** Helps you set up your new home and may include financial assistance for essential household items.

? Who is involved in my transition to a community setting?

Your transition team can include:

- Transition Coordinator
- Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) Case Manager
- Skilled Nursing Facility Staff
- Optional: Family, Friends, Community Members, Ombudsmen

? How do I qualify for Transition Services?

- Must be 18+ years old
- Live in a Skilled Nursing Facility
- Have Long Term Care Medicaid

Group In-Reach:

- Semi-annual presentations for residents and their support system with information about community living.

Individual In-Reach:

- One-on-one conversation about community living options.

- Your Transition Coordinator will help you set up a care team, find housing, and make a plan for moving day.
