

The Value of Dental Insurance




Fact: Nearly 100% of oral disease is preventable.

PPO Dentist - Payment is based on the PPO dentist's allowable fee, or the actual fee charged, whichever is less.

Premier Dentist - Payment is based on the Premier Maximum Plan Allowance (MPA), or the fee actually charged, whichever is less.

Non-Participating Dentist - Payment is based on the non-participating Maximum Plan Allowance. Members are responsible for the difference between the non-participating MPA and the full fee charged by the dentist. You will receive the best benefit by choosing a PPO dentist.
