Check for quality

The 2 blue hearts next to a doctor's name tells you they are a Premium Care Provider who has been reviewed by UnitedHealthcare and meets quality standards for delivering cost-effective care.

You may also see star ratings for customer satisfaction based on reviews from previous patients.

Understand the costs

Different providers may charge different amounts for the services they offer. Your search results will give you a range of the average costs for preventive care, medical procedures or behavioral health care in your area. And the individual provider listings show whose costs are below, above, or meet the local average.

If a procedure typically includes multiple steps of treatment, you can review the total cost and your estimated out-of-pocket cost for each step. So you'll know what to expect, from start to finish.

Your estimated out-of-pocket costs are personalized to you, based on your own benefit plan's deductible, annual out-of-pocket max, copay, coinsurance and how much you've paid toward your deductible.
