- City of Fort Collins IGA ready for signing \$3.58M
- Broadband Fund application submitted and ready to give presentation
- Capital Project Fund Grant schedule to open first week of May.
- USDA Reconnect Grant round 6 schedule for September (investigating Grant vs Loan Program)
- BEAD still expected to begin in early 2024

Community Project Request

- Support for Behavioral Health Center of Excellence
- Partnership including Colorado State University, SummitStone Health Partners, the Northern Colorado Health Alliance, and Larimer County's Longview Behavioral Health Campus
 - Expansion of CSU curriculum offerings
 - Community based teaching with experiential training/learning
 - Research focus
 - Increased diversity within the behavioral health workforce
 - Expand workforce as well as provide continuing education
 - Request for 2-year implementation support: \$560,000

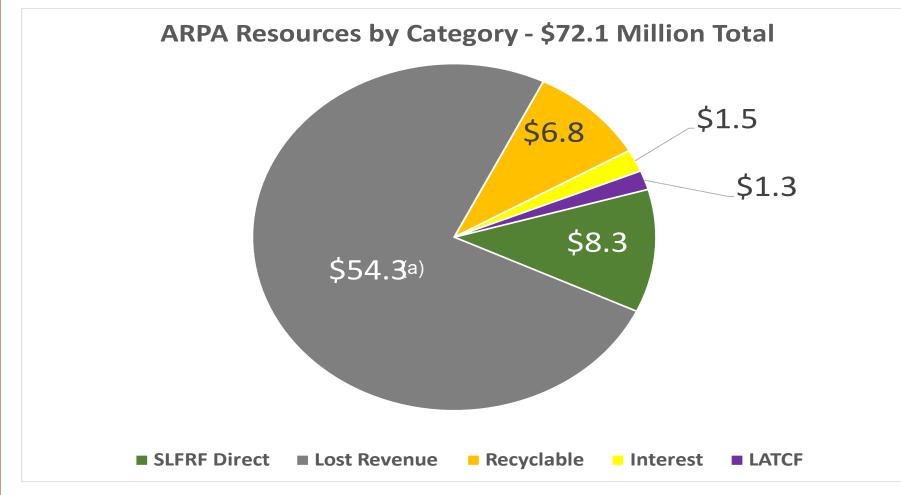


Immediate Needs Grants Financial Update

- Immediate Needs Grant Progress:
 - \$2.75 million in funding distributed*
 - \$309K remaining to be disbursed
 - 42 of 52 projects fully reimbursed*
 - 5 projects expire 3/31/23
 - 2 projects expire 6/30/23
 - 4 projects expire 12/31/23

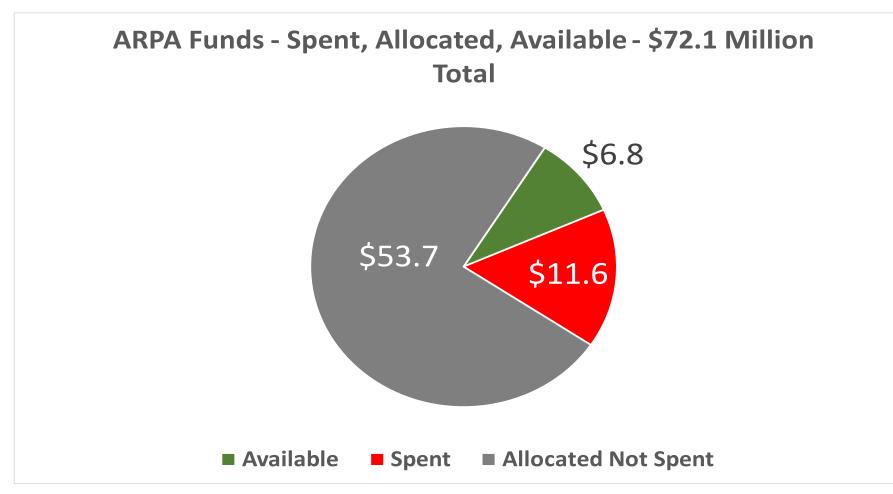






As of March 17, 2023 (a) = Behavioral Health Phase 2 switched to Lost Revenue





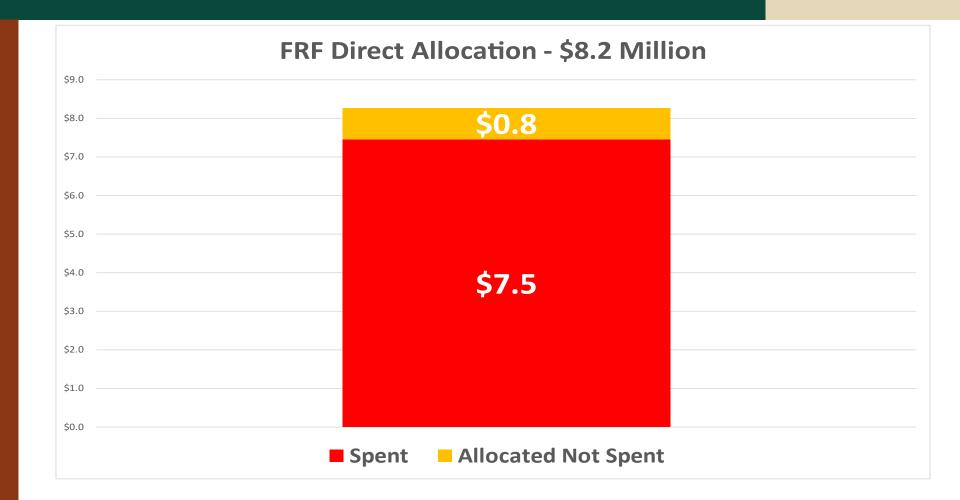

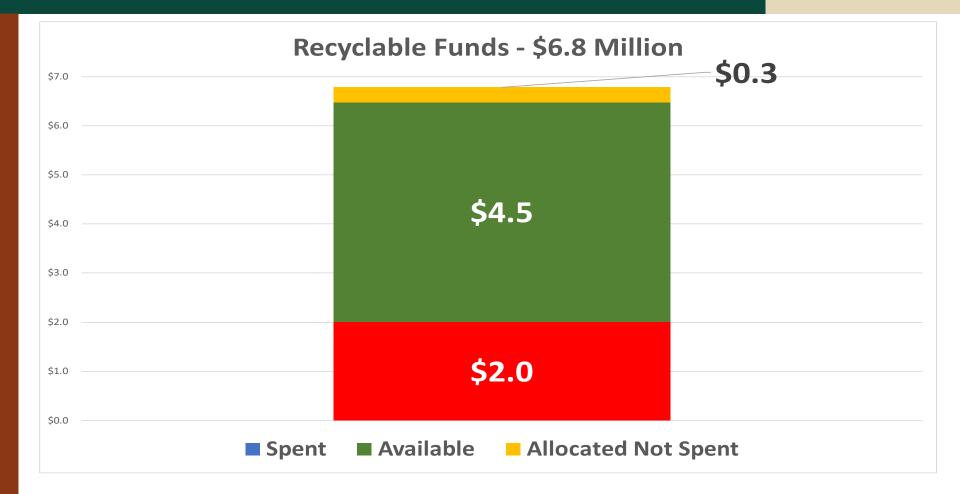

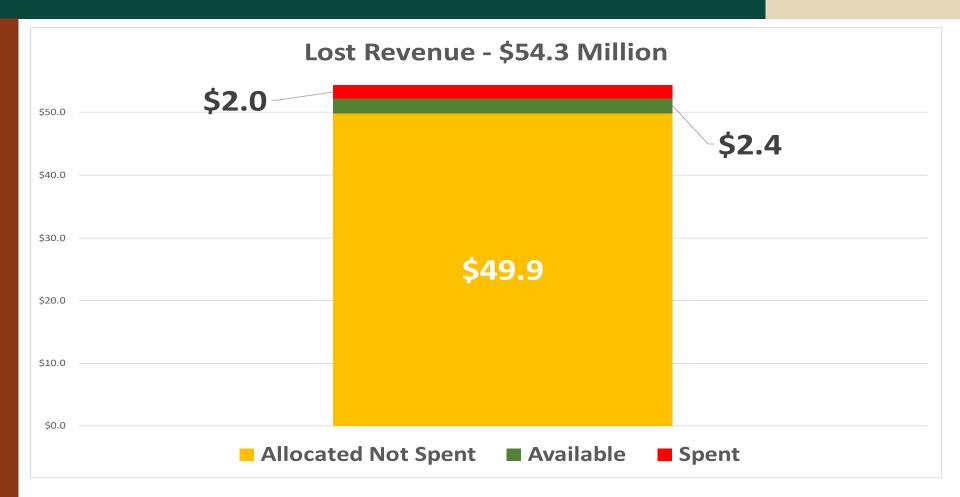
