Over the past few years, our Larimer County community has lost too many young people to gun violence. A total of 613 stolen firearms and 4,595 vehicle trespasses were reported across the county from 2016-2018. Many of those guns were unsecured in homes or vehicles and ended up in the hands of our county's youth.
