The Surest pre-enrollment website is designed to make it easier to find in-network providers and to see what your copays will be for next year.





DETERMINE WHAT PROVIDER IS RIGHT FOR YOU.

When considering a new healthcare provider, we know that this can be hard. It is wise to start by evaluating your current situation and identifying your top priorities. A thoughtful and organized approach can make the transition smoother and lead to a better patient-provider relationship.

Evaluate Surest Care Ratings

- Care Ratings are on a 1-10 scale, where 1 is the lowest care rating and 10 is the highest (best) care rating. Providers and facilities with a higher care rating have lower copays.
- Care Ratings are formulated by Surest/UHC based on historical patient data, and they will not change during the course of the year. Their rating as of January 1st is the rating that provider or facility will have for the entire year.
- Read online reviews: If available, the Surest site also includes online patient reviews from
 Healthgrades. Pay attention to feedback on bedside manner, communication, and staff
 professionalism. Healthgrades patient reviews have no bearing on Care Ratings or copay amounts.

VET YOUR CHOICES

After creating a short list of candidates, take a closer look to see which one is the best fit.

- Contact the office. Call the office to ask about availability, typical wait times, how they handle
 prescription refills, and whether they accept new patients. This is also a great way to get a feel for the
 office staff's demeanor.
- Consider logistics. Confirm the location and office hours are convenient for your schedule. Ask about after-hours care options, telehealth visits, and what hospitals they are affiliated with.
- Schedule a "meet and greet." Some practices allow you to schedule a brief consultation with a
 potential provider. This can help you assess their communication style, philosophy of care, and overall
 personality before committing to them.

MAKING THE SWITCH

If you decide to change providers, take the necessary steps to ensure a smooth transition.

- Ensure your medical records are transferred to your new provider.
- Schedule your first appointment. Come prepared with notes about your health history and any specific concerns you have.
- Pay attention to your first visit. Evaluate your experience after the first appointment. Did you feel
 comfortable, respected, and listened to? Did they answer your questions clearly? If you're not
 satisfied, don't hesitate to keep looking.
