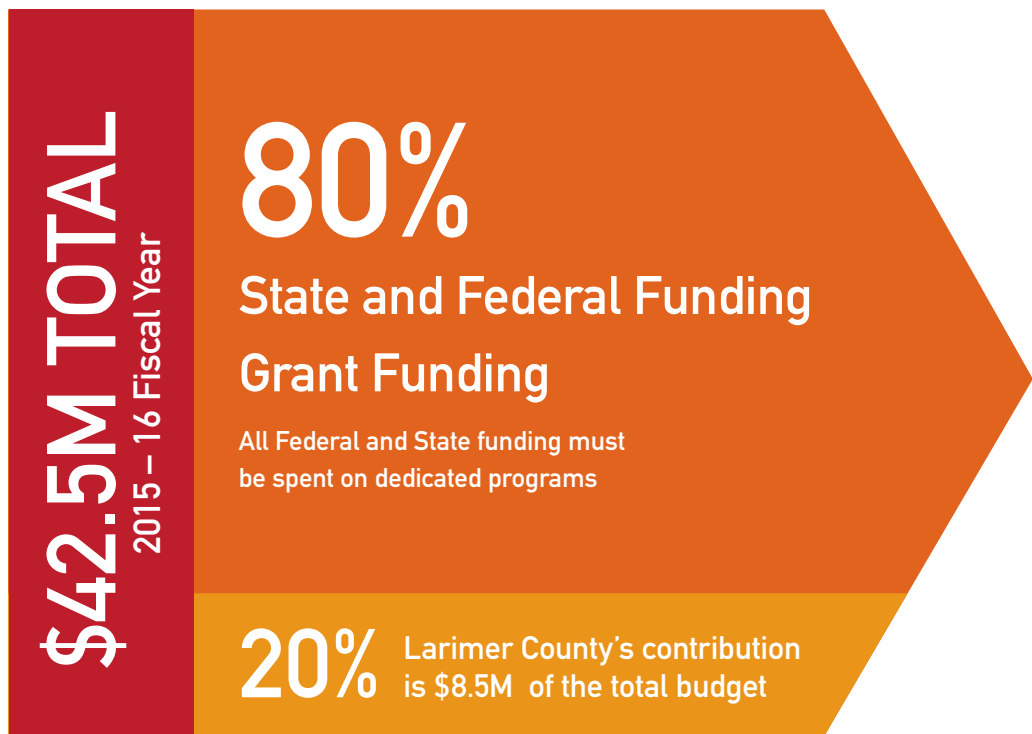


LARIMER COUNTY'S SAFETY NET FOR THOSE IN NEED
