### Roadway & Bridge Improvements Between County Roads 19 and 15

#### **PROJECT SCOPE**

- Improve and widen 2 miles of CR 70 between CR 19 and CR 15.
- Maintain one travel lane in each direction and reconstruct the pavement.
- Add 6 to 8 foot wide paved shoulders and improve sight distance at vertical curve crests.
- Replace two bridges over the North Poudre Irrigation Canal (one on CR 17 just north of CR 70 and another 0.6 miles east of CR 17). Replacement of several other drainage culverts are also included in the two mile improvement.
- Intersection improvements at CR 15 are not proposed with this phase.

#### **PROJECT PURPOSE**

- Adequately accommodate current and future traffic volumes.
  - o Average Daily Traffic (ADT) in 2008 = 1,300 vehicles per day
  - o 2016 ADT = 3,100 vehicles per day. Heavy trucks accounted for 14% of the 2016 ADT.
  - o The projected 2018 ADT in the 2008 Owl Canyon Study was 3,000 vehicles per day.
- Reduce recurring maintenance costs as this two mile stretch of CR 70 is only a chip seal surface.
- Improve sight distance at vertical crest curves and add a roadside safety buffer for steep slopes, trees, and ponds.

- Replace the CR 17 bridge over the North Poudre Irrigation Canal currently load posted for a maximum weight limit of 25 tons with a longer 26' x 10' concrete box culvert.
- Replace the narrow CR 70 bridge with a longer 22' x 8' concrete box culvert.


• Construction is anticipated to occur during the summer and fall of 2018.






