It is the policy of Larimer County to set alternative care rates to ensure that these types of care are available to CCCAP families.

Requirements for providers who provide Alternative Rate Care:

- The provider shall complete and return the fiscal agreement to the Department of Human Services indicating their intent and interest in providing alternative care.
- The provider shall submit a copy of their payment policies, which shall include policies for non-CCCAP (private pay) families for each type of alternative care and the type of alternative care offered by the provider.
- If the current fiscal agreement indicates that the provider does not provide alternative care, and the provider notifies the county of their intent to provide alternative care, an amended fiscal agreement will be sent to the provider.
