Subject: Loveland Police Department – Officer-Involved Shooting – 19-3494
Date: April 29, 2019

On 04/29/2019 at 4:41 pm, the Loveland Police Communications Center received multiple calls reference an armed robbery at Subway, 256 E. 29th St in Loveland, CO. The callers provided a description of the suspect who ran from the store.

Loveland officers located a male matching the description of the robbery suspect near the intersection of N. Madison and E. 29th St. One Loveland police officer fired their firearm striking the suspect. The suspect was taken to Medical Center of Rockies for injuries sustained from the shooting.

The Eighth Judicial District Critical Incident Response Team has been activated and are currently investigating this incident. The Loveland officer involved in the shooting will be placed on administrative leave with pay, which is standard in this type of incident. The Larimer County Sheriff's Office will be the lead investigative agency.

We do not anticipate releasing any further information at this time as the investigation is active.
