Man dies following August 16 officer-involved shooting

Alex Domina, the 19-year-old man injured during the August 16, 2021 Loveland officerinvolved shooting, was transported to the hospital following the incident. He remained hospitalized but succumbed to his injuries late on September 7 and was pronounced deceased.

The 8th Judicial Critical Incident Response Team (CIRT) investigated this officer-involved shooting and presented findings to the District Attorney on August 30. The case is currently under review and the District Attorney is expected to render a decision in early September.
