- Set trash racks on Copper Hill Dr and Miller Fork Rd.
 Trash racks still need to be fastened to the flared end section
- 2. Installed concrete block wall at the pinch point.
- 3. Excavated for revetment on Streamside Drive.
- 4. Poured downstream footers and upstream headwall on upper Streamside crossing.
- 5. Rough graded the overtopping adjacent to 635 Streamside Dr.

Upcoming Work

- 1. Pour downstream headwall/wingwalls on Upper Streamside Drive.
- 2. Pour 6" thick reinforced concrete deck at the pinch point.
- 3. Downstream Streamside crossing headwall, wingwalls, and overtopping structure.
- 4. Riprap and cover overtopping structure at 635 Streamside Dr.
- 5. Surface Black Creek Drive with 4" recycled asphalt or Class 5 road base

- 1. Ayers inspected the site on 12/17/2021. They will update plans and continue working on Phase III (Structure protection) design.
- 2. Mark Buckley visited the site and provided seeding recommendations.
- 3. Jerry to coordinate raising power lines with Estes Power.
