

**RESOLUTION 11172022A OF THE**

**Larimer County Department of Health and Environment**

**BOARD OF HEALTH**

**REQUEST FOR HEARING ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH SERVICES FEE SCHEDULE**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 25-1-506(3)(b)(XI), C.R.S., the Larimer County Board of Health ("Board of Health") has the power and the duty to initiate and carry out health programs consistent with state law that are necessary or desirable to protect public health and the environment; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 25-1-508(5)(g), C.R.S., the Board of Health has the power and duty to adopt rules not inconsistent with the public health law of this state; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 25-1-508(5)(j), the Board of Health has the power and duty to provide environmental health services, and to adopt fees to offset the cost of environmental health services in Larimer County to carry out its powers and duties; and

**WHEREAS**, Larimer County Department of Health and Environment ("Public Health") has recommended that the Board of Health amend the Larimer County Board of Health Regulations to adopt certain environmental health services fees for 2023 as indicated in Attachment "A" hereto, and incorporated by reference; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Health has determined that it is appropriate to conduct a public hearing to consider adoption of said fees, and to adopt such fees, as it deems appropriate, following the public hearing.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LARIMER COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH:**

1. That the Board of Health shall conduct a public hearing on December 15, 2022, commencing at 6:00 pm at their regular meeting to adopt a 2023 Environmental Health Fee Schedule as indicated in Attachment "A" hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
2. That following said hearing, the Board of Health shall adopt such fees and regulations as it deems appropriate.
3. That Public Health shall advertise said public hearing as provided by law.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 25-1-508(5)(j), and 25-10-107(1), C.R.S. the Board of Health has the power and duty to provide environmental health services, and to adopt fees to offset the cost of environmental health services in Larimer County to carry out its powers and duties; and

WHEREAS, Larimer County Department of Health and Environment has recommended that the Board of Health adopt environmental health fees that are fair and reasonable;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LARIMER COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH that the Larimer County Board of Health adopts the attached proposed 2023 Environmental Health Fee Schedule, to become effective January 1, 2023.
