Red Feather Lakes Public Restroom Project

- This project would replace existing vaulted privies (outhouses) located adjacent to the firehouse.
- There is a lack of public restrooms in the area of Red Feather where most businesses are located. While a larger wastewater treatment facility was studied, identifying a source of funding for the maintenance costs is a barrier to moving forward.
- Funding for maintenance of restroom facilities would be through a public improvement district.
- Site work ahead of a vote for the Public Improvement District in 2024 would consist of designing an on-site wastewater treatment system to serve the restrooms and estimates for costs of construction.
- **Direction sought:** Maintain allocation of \$500K to project?

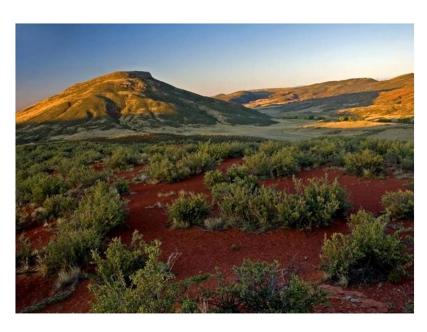

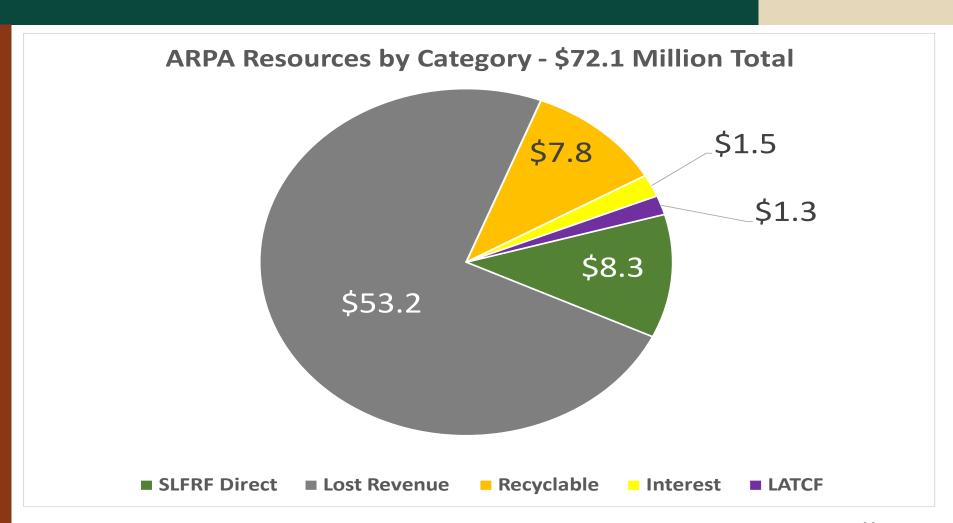




Immediate Needs Grants Financial Update

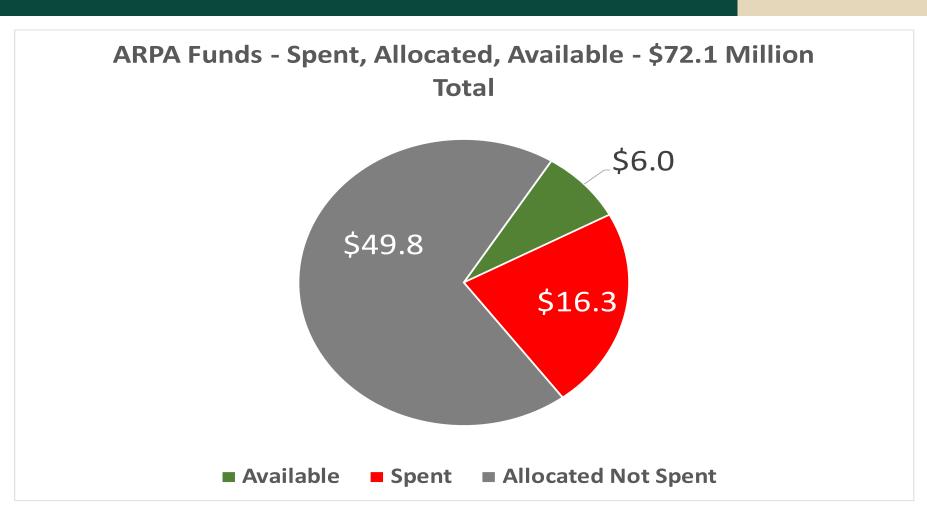
- Immediate Needs Grant Progress:
 - \$2.81 million in funding distributed*
 - \$234K remaining to be disbursed
 - 48 of 52 projects fully reimbursed or expired
 - 1 projects expired 6/30/23
 - 3 projects expire 12/31/23
 - Fort Collins Mobile Home Water project requesting additional \$18,500 due to cost overruns

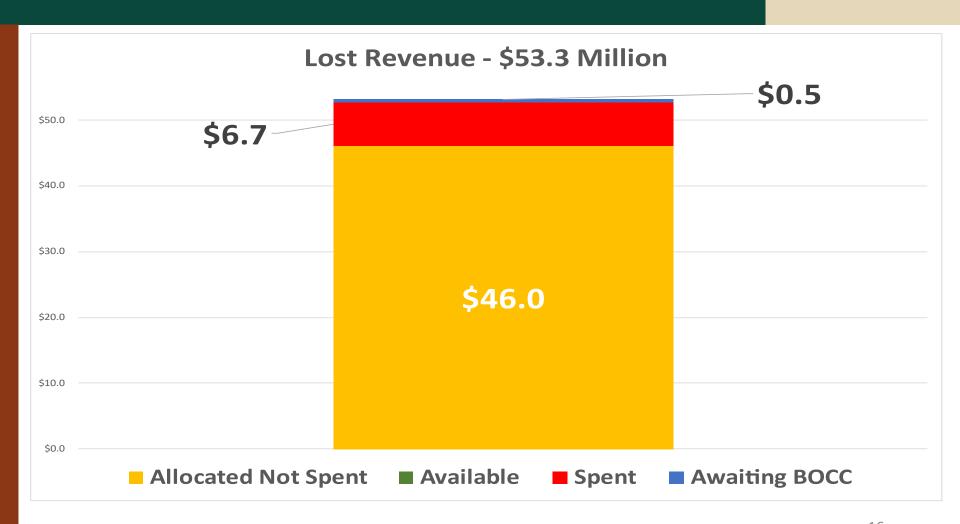
