## **BGCLC Present Day**

- 13 Clubs in Larimer County, with additional summer sites, serving over 2,000 youth every year
  - Fort Collins: 2 Clubs
  - Wellington: 1 Clubs
  - Loveland: 9 Clubs
  - Estes Park: 1 Club
- Clubs are are open daily after school from 2:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., and from 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. during summer and school breaks (hours may vary from site to site).





## **New Child Care Campus in Loveland**

- First campus in Larimer County to provide multiple youth and family-serving partners in one location
- United Way of Larimer County, Teaching Tree, and Early Childhood Council of Larimer County and BGCLC
- Youth between the ages of 0-18 can receive childcare and youth development, including mental health services and social-emotional learning programs
- At capacity, will serve 350 children per day and provide wrap-around services for local families in need
- BGCLC will complete purchase in May; renovations to begin in summer 2023, with a tentative opening date in early 2024
