



- PFE is a project created by our Age-Friendly Workplace Initiative team to inform business owners and HR teams about the many benefits of hiring and retaining an age-diverse workforce, including:

- We recently partnered with the Larimer County Workforce Center to extend outreach across more businesses in Larimer County via the Workforce Innovation Grant.
