WHEREAS, in 2008, Colorado passed the Public Health Reauthorization Act, Section 25-1-505, C.R.S., which requires local public health agencies to create a five-year Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP) based on a Community Health Assessment that identifies key health issues; and,

WHEREAS, 2024 through 2029 is the next five-year time period for implementing the Larimer County CHIP; and,

WHEREAS, the mission of the Larimer County Department of Health and Environment (LCDHE) is to provide everyone in Larimer County the opportunity for a healthy life; and,

WHEREAS, in 2022 and 2023, the LCDHE conducted and presented a Community Health Assessment (CHA), entering into an inclusive, community-engaged, and data-driven process to develop actionable CHIP priorities and strategies for improving overall community health in Larimer County; and,

WHEREAS, through approval of the 2024-2029 CHIP, the LCDHE serves as the Health Strategist in addressing population health and convening cross-sector collaborations that support shared ownership, implementation, evaluation, and collective impact of CHIP activities; and,

WHEREAS, the Larimer County Board of Health wishes to endorse and support the 2024-2029 CHIP approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Larimer County Board of Health, on behalf of the LCDHE, do hereby resolve that the proposed 2024-2029 CHIP be approved.
