**You may be prosecuted for perjury in the second degree under section 18-8-503, C.R.S., if you sign this affirmation and do not believe it to be true or is not or have not been a first responder or the spouse or civil union partner of a first responder.**

## Form FAQ

### Which ID do I have to provide?

If you have a Colorado Driver's License or Colorado ID card, you must provide that number.

If you don't have a Colorado Driver's License or Colorado ID card, you can provide the last 4 digits of your SSN.

If you don't have a Colorado Driver's License, Colorado ID card, or SSN, check the box. You may be required to provide an acceptable ID from the list on [GoVoteColorado.gov](https://govotecolorado.gov).

### Which information will be made confidential with this request form?

This form requests confidentiality for the address(s) in your voter registration record. It does not apply to any addresses associated with you that may be located in other public records.

If you are or were a first responder, or a spouse or civil union partner of a first responder, you may be eligible to make additional address information located in other public records confidential as well. Contact your county clerk about other opportunities to make your address confidential.

### Which address do I have to provide?

You must provide the address where you currently live (no PO box). If you have another address where you receive mail you must provide that address too (PO box allowed).

### What is considered a First Responder?

A first responder is anyone who is, or has been, one of the following:

- Peace officer
- Firefighter
- Volunteer firefighter
- Emergency medical service provider
- Emergency communications specialist; or
- The spouse or civil union partner of any of the above.

### What is considered a Protected Profession?

A "protected professional" is anyone who is, or has been, one of the following:

- Educator
- Code enforcement officer
- Human services worker
- Public health worker
- Child representative
- Health-care worker
- Reproductive health-care services worker
- Officer or agent of State Bureau of Animal Protection
- Animal control officer
- Office of the respondent parents' counsel staff member or contractor
- Judge
- Peace officer
- Prosecutor
- Public defender
- Public safety worker
- Election official or election worker

### Why do you ask for my phone number and email?

We ask for your phone number and email in case we have a question about your application. Your email and phone number are confidential.

Your ballot and other election mail will still be sent by regular mail.

### By making my voter record confidential what information will I have access to online voter registration and ballot tracking?

No. If you make your voter record confidential you will not be able to access your voter registration information online or make changes or updates to your voter registration online. To update your voter registration information you will need to provide a completed voter registration form to your county clerk.

Additionally, you will not receive texts or emails about ballot tracking updates if you have previously signed up for such updates.

### Can I participate in precinct caucuses?

If your record is confidential, you will not be included on the precinct caucus list used to determine precinct caucuses eligibility. However, you may still be able to participate by completing a separate voter eligibility affidavit at the time of the caucus.
