To qualify to use the Business Hazardous Waste Disposal Program, businesses must be Very Small Quantity Generators (VSQG) of hazardous waste.  
VSQGs generate:

- less than 220 pounds of hazardous waste
- less than 2.2 pounds of acute hazardous waste per month
- accumulate less than 2,200 pounds of hazardous waste on site at any one time.

Full information regarding generator status is found in the Colorado Code or Regulations 6 CCR 1007-3 Part 262.
